



## **GIANT MOSAIC I QUILT**

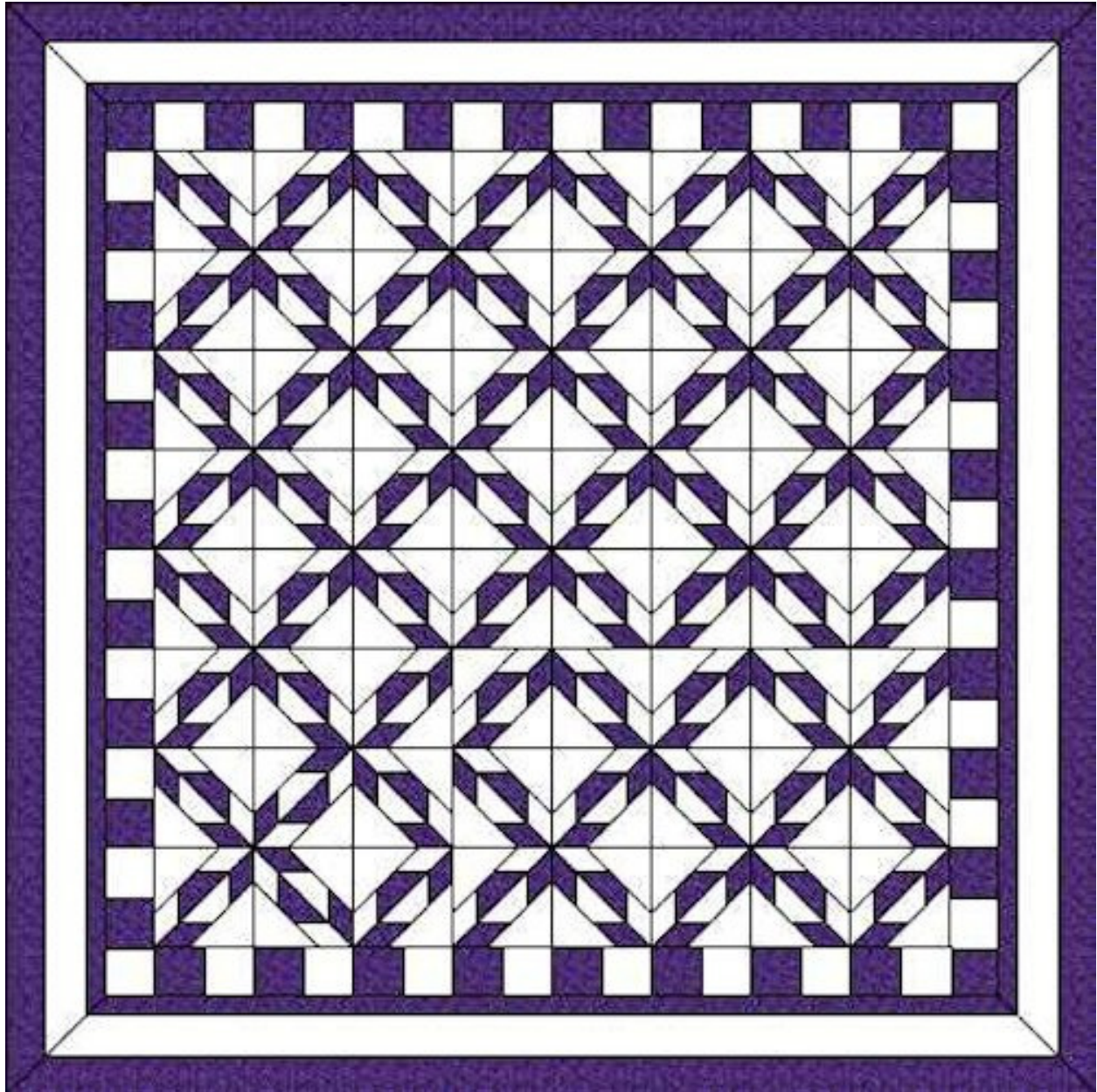

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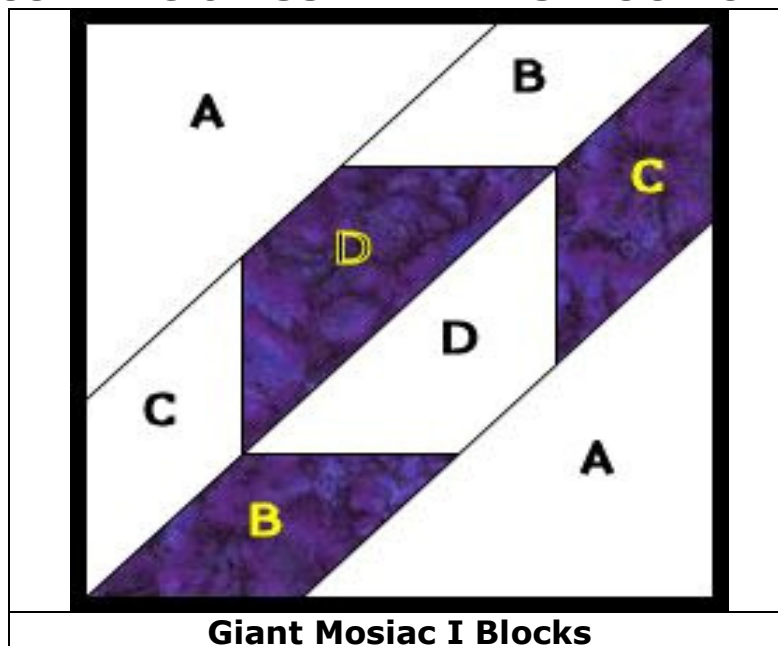

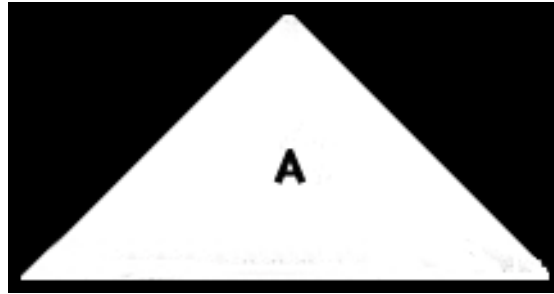
### CUTTING & ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



Read instructions thoroughly before beginning. You have been furnished pattern pieces with all the major pieces with seam allowances from our original draftings. Cut out your templates from poster paper or quilting plastic. The individual sections are cutting strips and joining them. Cut them carefully and keep a master piece in case you damage your pattern pieces that you are working with.

Here is the basic layout of your main quilt block. You will construct 64 main 8" block sections according to cutting guides on the pages of this pattern and then put them together for the full quilt. Keep referring to the colored picture on the front of the pattern. This is very important as the fabrics supplied are cut to go with this coloration. Just follow the instructions for the block.

## SECTION #A

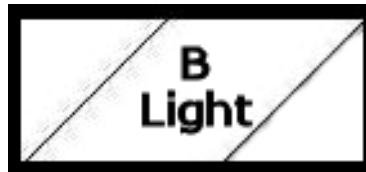


First identify the pattern piece for section A. Cut as per chart below. Cut 7" strips and then cut into 7" squares. Yields 6 squares per strip. Cut across diagonally across the squares to make the triangles. (1/2 Sq. Triangles). You will need 128 total triangles.

## SECTION B-Light



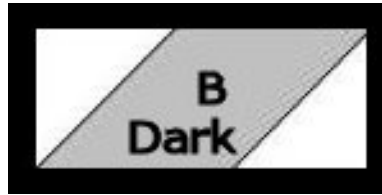
First identify pattern pieces for the B-Light sections. Cut as per chart below. Cut 3" strips and then place the pattern piece as the diagram and Cut 64 pieces.

## SECTION B-Dark



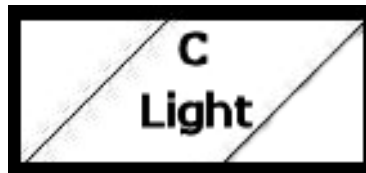
First identify pattern pieces for the B-Dark sections. Cut as per chart below. Cut 3" strips and then place the pattern piece as the diagram and Cut 64 pieces.

## SECTION C-Light



First identify pattern pieces for the C-Light sections. Cut as per chart below. Cut 3" strips and then place the pattern piece as the diagram and Cut 64 pieces.

## SECTION C-Dark



First identify pattern pieces for the C-Dark sections. Cut as per chart below. Cut 3" strips and then place the pattern piece as the diagram and Cut 64 pieces.



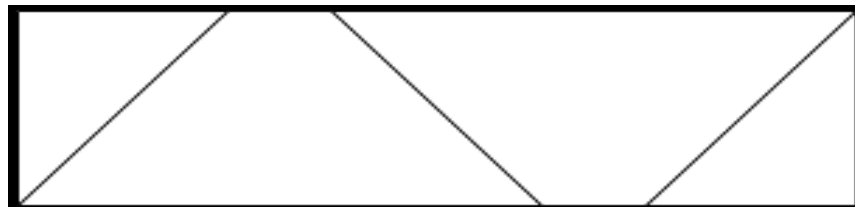

## SECTION D- Light



First identify pattern pieces for the D-Light sections. Cut as per chart below. Make 4 sections just alike. Cut 3" strips and then place the pattern piece as the diagram and cut 64 pieces.

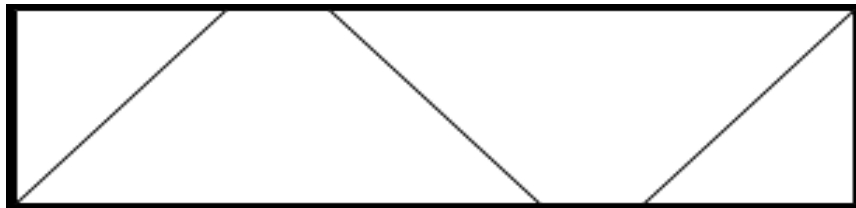

## SECTION D-Dark



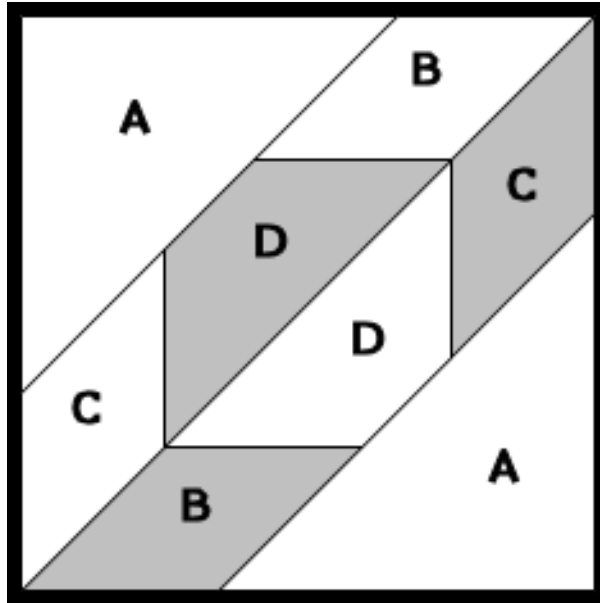
First identify pattern pieces for the D-Dark sections. Cut as per chart below. Cut 2 1/2" strips and then place the pattern piece as the diagram and cut 64 pieces.

D-Dark	11	Yields 6 pc. ea

## Piece the 64 main blocks

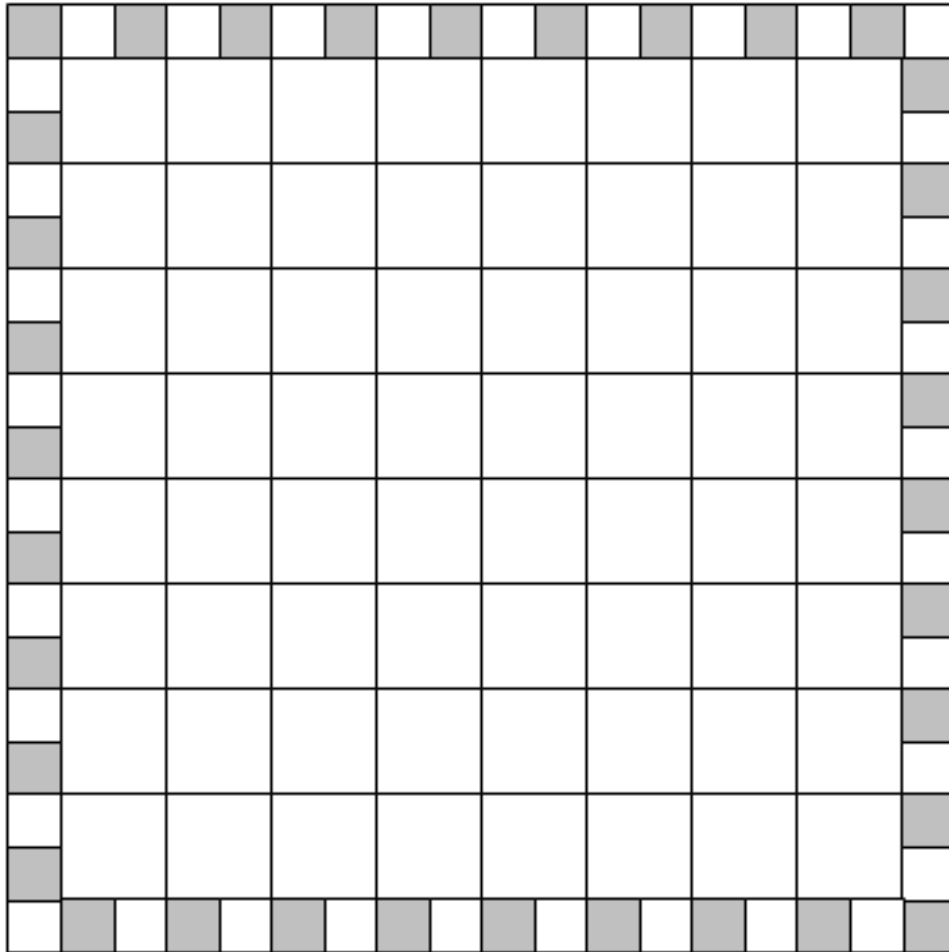


Now construct your 64 blocks for the main quilt top piecing as per the diagram. We suggest you piece the center strips first, join them in the middle and add the "A" pieces to square each block.

Now piece and an set all 64 blocks like the picture of the quilt at the top of the page and press everything to the outside. Proceed to the border section.



## Block Border #1



**We will now construct the block border section #5. Cut 34 each color of squares into 5 1/2" squares and assemble them as the diagram above. Attach to the quilt top and press to the outside.**

### Cutting Guide Section #5

Colors	5 1/2" Strips	Yields 5 1/2" Squares
<b>Light</b>	<b>5</b>	<b>35</b>
<b>Dark</b>	<b>5</b>	<b>35</b>

## **BORDERS**

**Cut your final border pieces out now.**

**Outside Border #1—Cut 9-2 1/2" strips of color #Light and sew to quilt.**

**You will need to piece this border. 2 1/4 strips per side.**

**Outside Border #2—Cut 9-4 1/2" strips of color #Light and sew to quilt.**

**You will need to piece this border. 2 1/4 strips per side.**

**Outside Border #3—Cut 12-4 1/2" strips of color #Dark and sew to quilt. You will need to piece this border. 3 strips per side.**

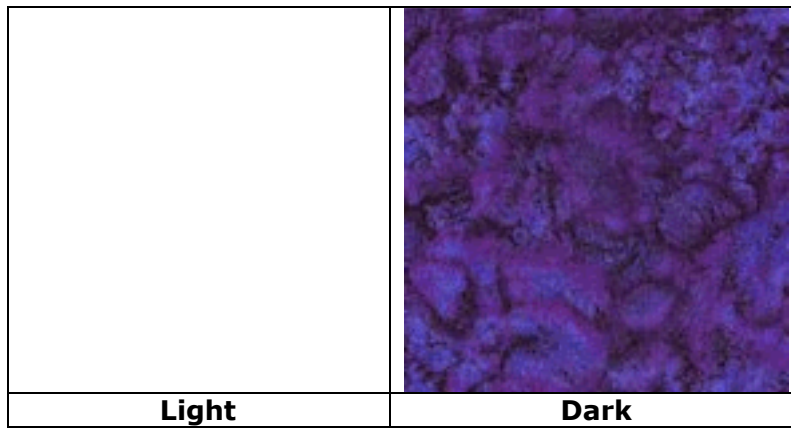
**When sewing the borders to the quilt you may miter the corners or Sew them on straight across the ends for a square look.**

## **FINISHING THE QUILT**

**Make your backing as usual, place on large table and layer the batting.**

**Place top on top of the sandwich. Then baste and quilt in the usual manner. I like to quilt in the ditch on these types of quilts so that you don't "shadow" the design with the quilting in 1/4" as is standard. But as Mom used to say "do the way YOU want". That way it's yours.**
